Rotary Peace Fellowships are intended for individuals with:

- A career related to international relations, sustainable development, peace and conflict resolution, human rights and public health
- Work experience in these areas
- Real potential to positively impact our world.

NB Rotarians, Honorary Rotarians, Rotarian families and lineal descendants are ineligible

110 Rotary Peace Fellowships are offered each year on an internationally competitive basis at Rotary Peace Centres in 7 prestigious universities around the world

- 60 Masters Degree Fellowships
- 50 Professional Development Certificate

Masters Degree Fellowships

TWO YEAR MASTERS DEGREE – Building the Leaders of TOMORROW

Up to 2 years of **fully funded graduate study** at a Rotary Peace Centre in the US, Japan, UK, Australia or Sweden.

Theoretical and practical learning experiences in conflict, theories of international relations and models of cooperation, conflict resolution and negotiation, including a 3 month field experience

Funding for round trip travel, tuition and fees, board and other limited expenses - average \$US76,000

This program requires a bachelor's degree in a related field and 3 years of relevant work experience

3 MONTHS PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT CERTIFICATE – Strengthening the Leaders of TODAY

Designed for mid-career professionals already working in leadership positions in the field of peace and conflict resolution

Chulalongkorn University in Bangkok – Sessions: January-April and June-August

Fully funded course offers a mix of theory & practical skills both in the classroom at & in on-site field study interactions.

This program requires a bachelor's degree in a related field and 5 years of related work experience.
