How are participants selected?

- They can be approached by a Rotary Club or a community leader or they can apply directly online
- For the 2014 program they must be between the age of 18 & 27 on or before 1/01/2014
- They must be an active leader in their community or have leadership aspirations
- They must complete an application form and be interviewed by the sponsoring Rotary Club

- Linked with your Rotary Club and be able to present to the club their conference experience and community leadership role and aspirations
- Attend a conference conducted by professional trainers and leading presenters
