Day to Day ITINERARY

Day 1 13 May 2016 Depart Sydney International airport on Singapore airlines 6pm flight to Osaka, via Singapore. Check in & meet Barry Antees at 3pm



Day 2 14 May - 9am arrival at OSAKA to be met by your Japanese Guide, for a day of relaxation & recovery, with an afternoon city tour visiting Aerial Aerial Garden Observatory, Umeda District, Osaka Castle & Sinsaibashi Bridge. **Dinner at your own expense.

Day 3 15 May Some morning time around Osaka before driving to Kyoto, where you will be visiting Gion the Geisha area for dinner. (B L D)


Day 4 – 16 May This morning is around Kyoto visiting the famous Golden Pavilion Kinkajuji & the Heian Jingu shrine before boarding the Bullet train to Hiroshima (B L D)



Day 5 – 17 May You will be taken around the sights of Hiroshima today, to include, Miyajima, Itsukushima shrine, Hiroshima Peace & Memorial Park, view the Atomic Bomb Dome, before the drive onto Fukoaka. (B L D)

Day 6 – 18 May A day around Fukoaka visiting Kushida Shrine, Hakata folk Museum, Fukuoka Castle Ruins, Ohori Park Japanese gardens, Canal City Hakata (B L D)

Day 7 – 19 May FUKOAKA – BUSAN Sth KOREA.....You will be transferred to the Fukoaka Ferry terminal for your 3 hr ferry to Busan in Sth Korea (B)







Day 8 – 20 May A full day trip around Busan Sth Korea to include, APEC Nurimaru, Yonggungsa Temple, Taejongdae Park, Gwangan Bridge, Gwangan Beach, Busan Cinema Centre, Marine City (B L D)

Day 9 - 21 May This morning drive approx. 1 hr to Gyeongju, visit Seokguram
 Grotto, Bulguksa Temple, Tumuli Park, Cheomseongdae Observatory, National
 Museum before a relaxing evening (B L D)

Day 10 – 22 May Today's journey is to Daegu, approx. 2hrs driving where you visit Donghwasa, Dodong-seowon Confucian academy, Daegu Apsan Park, Daegu Arboretum, Herb Hills, Yangnyeongsi Museum of Medicine. (B L D)

Day 11 – 23 May Journey approx. an hour this morning to Andong, where you visit the Hahoe Village, Andong Hanji to see Korean paper making, then onto Sokcho a further 3hrs journey, where you stay tonight (B L D)







Day 12 – 24 May On the way to Seoul today you visit the Mt.Seorak National Park, Kwonkeumsung Fortress, including the cable car & the Shineungsa Temple. Your arrival into Seoul will be where you now stay for the next 9 nights (B L D)

Day 13 – 25 May A day trip to the DMZ – this is a lovely day around the country area to see, hear & visit the Demilitarised zone – DMZeeee as they call it (B L D)

Day 14 – 26 May A full day tirp to the area of Suwon, visit a folk museum, the Suwon Fortress before returning for the night in Seoul (B L D)

Day 15 - 27 May - This morning enjoy a city sightseeing tour around Seoul, the Han River passing many spectacular architectural designed buildings, the Horin Art Centre
 (B L) *** Dinner by own arrangements tonight

Day 16 – Day 21 28 May – 2 June - The ROTARY WORLD CONVENTION, in walking distance at COEX Breakfast is included daily while convention is on, all other meals own arrangements

Day 22 June You transfer today will take you to the airport for your 4.40pm Singapore airlines flight back to Sydney (or any Australian city) via Singapore. Singapore is a fantastic stopover if you have never seen Singapore or you wish a small relaxing break.

Day 23 3 June If you fly through the night you arrive in Sydney at 9.15am today (there is an option to depart Seoul at 12.10AM to arrive Sydney 4.45pm same date)
