Professor Greg Nelson has been in Cardiology practice since 1984 and has been involved in the development of the process of field triage for primary angioplasty in acute myocardial infarction. He has helped establish the concept of the Regional Heart Attack Centre at the co-

located cardiac catheter laboratory of the RNSH and the North Shore Private Hospitals. Professor Nelson has published over 70 papers in peer reviewed journals. He has been primary investigator in over 20 multicentre randomised controlled trials at the RNSH.



Robert Pennicott started his first business as a fisherman in the waters of southern Tasmania, before creating Bruny Island Cruises in 1999. His enthusiasm for the business has seen it evolve into a worldclass ecotourism experience. In 2007, Robert founded the Tasmanian Coast

Conservation Fund in concert with Wildcare. In May 2011, Robert launched his own fund, the Pennicott Foundation, which allows his business to directly contribute to its own nature conservation projects. In 2011 Rob led a special expedition to drive two Yellow dinghies around Australia to raise over \$259,000 for Polio Plus – an amazing feat of endurance!



Dr Sam Prince is a 27 year old entrepreneur, medical doctor, and philanthropist. He established a fresh Mex grill franchise while studying medicine at the age of 21. He grew Zambrero to over 15 stores and counting, 170 staff and over

\$10 million in revenue. Paying homage to his parents' modest origins in rural Sri Lanka, Sam has set his will towards democratising healthcare and education for young people in Australia and across the globe. Sam created The Emagine Foundation in 2007. They have built and equipped 15 IT learning centres in rural Sri Lanka to date. Sam is currently Chairman of One Disease at a Time, an aid organisation which aims to systematically eliminate infectious diseases from Australia for good, one at a time.



Dr Tim Sharp is one of Australia's leaders in the exciting new science of positive psychology and happiness. He is one of Australia's leading Executive Coaches – highly qualified on matters relating to human behaviour and psychology. A prolific author, in 2014 he released a

publication titled "Live Happier Live Longer – your guide to positive ageing". Dr. Sharp's passion and energy has shifted away from traditional, clinical psychology and toward "positive psychology". He founded The Happiness Institute in late 2003.



Gemma Sissia. At 22 years old Gemma Sisia travelled to Uganda to volunteer as a teacher. This experience led to a belief that a free, high-quality education should be the right of all children in the world and that education is the strongest weapon in the fight against poverty, corruption and

political instability. Upon returning to Australia, Gemma raised enough money to start an official fund to invest in the education of East Africa's poorest children. Along with the gift of a small plot of land in Arusha, Tanzania, Gemma built The School of St Jude with the help of friends, family and Rotary groups. The school provides quality education to over 1,900 students from communities in Tanzania.



Simon Kent-Jones joined Ord Minnett in October 2006 from Macquarie Bank, where he has worked for over 13 years, most recently establishing and running the Macquarie Financial Services Group private client research team for their 280
