Then please assure that all these items are sent to District Administrator Olivia Poe (admin@rotarydistrict5170.org) or to me **prior to November 1, 2019**. Interviews for the position will be conducted on Saturday, November 16, 2019, time and location to be announced. All nominations will be handled in accordance with the bylaws of Rotary International.

An informational workshop for those interested will be held on Saturday, September 21, 2019 from 1-3 p.m. at Los Gatos Lodge, 50 Los Gatos Saratoga Road, Los Gatos, CA. Please encourage curious members or potential candidates to attend. (Spouses and significant others are very welcome.) A panel of Past Governors will provide input and answer questions.
