- Proven record of success in academic field;
- Commitment to community service;
- Well-defined career goals;
- Concrete ideas for advancing within chosen field;
- Language fluency in the host international institution or location of study;
- sincerity in securing rotary relationships upon scholarship completion;
- Accepted sponsorship by the study institution outside of the united states at the time of the interview;
- Officially sponsored by a rotary club in our district (club to screen application);
- Applicant will be hosted by an international rotary club, approved and confirmed by the rotary foundation officers.
