# **Notice of Application for District Governor 2019-2020**

The time has come to nominate individuals to serve as the 2019-2020 District Governor for Rotary District 5170.

Below is an excerpt from a letter from District Nominating Committee Chair PDG Loren Harper to Club Presidents explaining the process.

"For one of your club members the opportunity is here to take a bold, exciting step in Rotary Leadership. The District Nominating Committee is now seeking nominations for the office of District Governor Nominee Designate. This individual would serve in 2019-2020.

The role of a District Governor is to lead, encourage and equip other Rotarians in their leadership roles as well as share in the successes of all the Rotary clubs within the District. The District Governor Nominee Designate will train with Rotary International leaders, travel to Rotary International conventions and, as District Governor, visit with each one of the clubs in the District. This is an excellent opportunity to lead and enrich one's own leadership skills; to encourage and be encouraged; to develop relationships with individuals throughout the District and throughout the world and to exemplify the Rotary spirit of Service above Self. "

Rotary International's 2013 Manual of Procedure lists the following as qualifications for the District Governor Nominee. "At the time of selection, the nominee will be called governor-nominee-designate and will assume the title of governor-nominee on 1 July two years before serving as governor. The governor-nominee must

- 1) Be a regular member of a club in the district (RIB 15.070.1.)
- 2) Have full qualifications for membership in the strict application of the club membership provisions, and have a classification whose integrity is without question (RIB 15.070.2.)
- 3) Have served as president of a club for a full term or be a charter president of a club having served the full term from the date of the charter to 30 June, provided that this period is for at least six months (RIB 15.070.3.)
- 4) Demonstrate willingness, commitment, and ability, physically and otherwise, to fulfill the duties and responsibilities of the office of governor as provided in RI Bylaws section 15.090. (RIB 15.070.4.)
- 5) Demonstrate knowledge of the qualifications, duties, and responsibilities of governor as prescribed in the RI Bylaws, and submit to RI, through its general secretary, a signed statement acknowledging a clear understanding of them. This statement shall also confirm that the Rotarian is qualified for the office of governor and willing and

able to assume the duties and responsibilities of the office and to perform them faithfully (RIB 15.070.5.) "

Each Rotary club in the District may nominate one of its members for District Governor Nominee Designate, or propose a member of another club with the latter club's concurrence.

A nomination form and a biographical information sheet must be filled out (see link below) and returned to District Administrator, Olivia Poe (admin@rotarydistrict5170.org) by October 31, 2016, Monday.

Interviews for the position will be conducted on November 5, 2016, Saturday.

All nominations will be handled in accordance with Article 13 of the By Laws of Rotary International.
