This new feature is being added to our District website to permit service projects and fundraisers to be posted and shared by our District membership.

You will note two main features:

Post A Project

Within this drop-down menu section is the ability to:

Post A “Service” Project or

Post A “Fundraiser”

Both cases open specific forms to be completed. Once completed and with the selection of the “Submit” button, your information is forwarded to specific District leaders who will review the information. That information will then be loaded into the “Find A Project” section.

Find A Project

Within this drop-down menu section is the ability to:

View “Service” Projects

View “Fundraisers”

View “Global Grants”

The first two cases open the specific data presented during the “Post A Project.” The “Global Grants” data is loaded by our District Global Grant’s Chair. The data is a reflection of our Rotary Foundation projects.
