LEADERSHIP & VIBRANCY

In this you will learn Leadership skills that will help your club reach new heights of vibrancy, and help YOU achieve your potential as a leader in Rotary and in your business life.

SERVICE & FUNDRAISING

In this course you will not only gain in-depth knowledge of each of the Avenues of Service, but learn to explain, promote and earn support for them, inside your Club and with "Other People's Money".

MEMBERSHIP

This course will answer this question and provide key strategies for moving a club into "growth mode", and to expand its ability to engage a greater number of members. You will also walk away with a recruitment and retention strategy for a static club.
