

- \$ 1500 Additional Rebate for low income household
- \$ 1500 Volunteer Labor Contribution
- \$ 6000 Total Value
- Cost to low-income household\$0Cost to other households\$1500



## ROOFTOP SOLAR FOR NONPROFITS

Low-Income Multi-Family Housing Funding

- \$ 4,000 Cupertino Rotary
- \$ 3,400 West Valley Community Services (owner)
  \$14,600 Hammond Climate Solutions
  \$ 8,000 Volunteer Labor Contribution
  \$30,000 Total Value
