WHAT IS ROTARY? WHY JOIN ROTARY?

Rotary is a global volunteer community service organization operating in over 200 countries. Rotary's ideal of service is to encourage and foster:

- FIRST: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity of service addressing poverty, hunger, disease, environmental issues, etc.
- SECOND: High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;
- 3. THIRD: The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;
- 4. FOURTH: The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

WHAT IS THE ROTARY PASSPORT CLUB?

The Rotary Passport Club is a district level club consisting of members who fulfil their Rotary mission by creating and/or participating in service projects, fellowship events, and club meetings hosted by any of the clubs in District 5170.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS OF MEMBERSHIP?

- Those seeking to join the Rotary Passport club need to:
- * Complete this Proposal for Membership Form.
 - * Be sponsored by a current Rotarian in good standing.
 - * Be of good character and high ethical standard.
 - * Submit a one-time enrollment fee (\$15) on approval.
 - * Pay annual membership dues (\$180).
 - * Participate/contribute to service activities annually, including Rotary/Committee meetings, and projects.

WHO ARE CANDIDATES FOR THE PASSPORT CLUB?

- Rotary Passport Club was conceived for several groups:
- (1) For people who cannot join a traditional Club due to time and financial considerations.
 - (2) For people who are unsure of which Club to join within the District who want to experience what all the Clubs have to offer (a starting point).
 - (3) For former Rotarians who left their Club due to financial, time, or other considerations, but who still maintain the desire to give and serve.
 - (4) For current Rotarians who have made the decision to leave their current club, but still want to be a Rotarian (members in life transition).
