Phase III: Birdhouse Construction



The third and final phase of our restoration project in Grand Lake after the East Troublesome Fire is the construction and installation of **30 birdhouses**, replacing those that were lost during the fire, around the Grand Lake Metro Recreation District trails.

You can participate in three ways:

- build a birdhouse on your own using the plans provided below - you will be reimbursed for expenses from the funds raised to support this project
- build a birdhouse [using a kit](#) provided by the District 5450 Colorado Wildfire Relief Fund
- install the birdhouses during a work day to be scheduled in the early spring

The 30 birdhouses must be built by March 31.

We will announce the work day later in the season.
