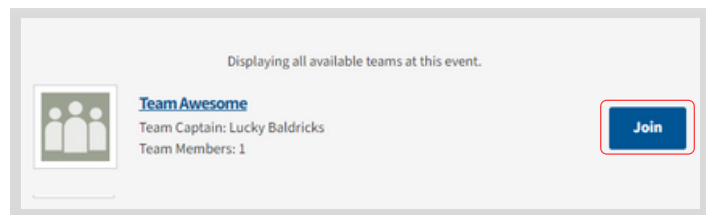
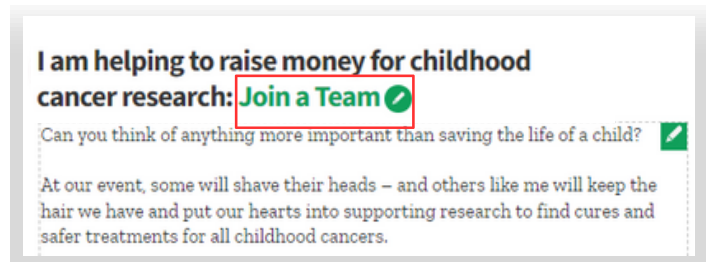
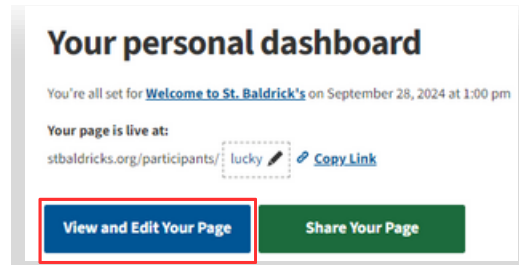
Are you registered?

If you're already registered...

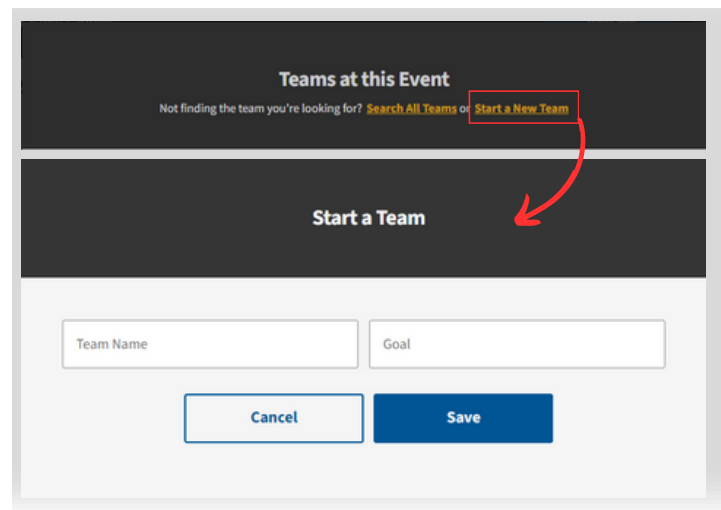
Join a Team:
