

Global Grants 2026-27

Guidelines

- Club qualification is required for clubs writing Global Grants and those seeking to access D. 5450 Global Grant DDF as partners.
- Rotaract Clubs seeking to contribute to Global Grants must sign the D. 5450 MOU.
- To reserve D. 5450 GG DDF the international partner club writing the grant must submit the 2026-27 request form signed by the grant champion and club president to Robertmintz@comcast.net
- GG DDF reservations are valid for 90 days and can be reallocated after 90 days unless the GG has received a “Tagged “status by the TRF staff.
- Each club is eligible to request up to \$15,000 in GG DDF on a first-come availability basis.
- D. 5450 matches for 2026-27 are \$1.25 for every club \$ 1.00 up to a maximum of \$25,000 per GG.
- D. 5450 match for GG’s originating from other districts is \$1 for \$1 match until 2026-7 funds are exhausted. Previous years surplus funds cannot be used.
- The Rotary Foundation will match Districts DDF at \$.80 for each district \$1 from the TRF World Fund.
- GGs should be submitted before March 31, 2027
- Starting in 2027-28 clubs with more than three grants open or with grants open one year after the last funds have been spent cannot apply for new grants.
- Global Grant Resources are available online on MyRotary.org in the Learning Center under Rotary Foundation Grants Management.
- Rotary Foundation staff and volunteer Cadre specialists are available to help and can be facilitated through myself and my team
