

Take US Hwy. 34 from Granby towards Grand Lake and RMNP. Turn left on County Road 48, just past the turn off to the Town of Grand Lake and the Visitor Center. This is the road to the Grand Lake Golf Course and Sloopy's Grill is on the corner. Go approximately 1 mile to the Trails Parking Area (across from Three Lakes Water and Sanitation). If you go all the way to the golf course, you've gone too far.
