

ACTIVE SENIOR ROTARIAN AWARD

Begun in 1994 as the Active Senior Active Award, this award seeks to honor an active senior Rotarian (based upon a membership type formerly known as "Senior Active") who exhibits an energetic level of participation in his or her club and community.

The competition is always on the highest level, requiring the award committee to make difficult choices, for everyone who is nominated has already been a winner by helping his or her club and community.

This award is reserved for members who have provided substantial years of service to Rotary. It is regarded as a mark of Rotary distinction in itself. The member must have completed service at **one** of the following levels:

- 15 years of Rotary Club service; or
- 10 years of Rotary Club service and has reached the age of 60; or
- 5 years of Rotary Club service and has reached the age of 65; or
- Served as District Governor, thereafter remaining active in his or her club.
