- III. The project will be judged on:
 - the information presented in the Application
 - (If available) key points of the display at the District Conference

Your written Application can be up to two letter-size pages in length (10pt font minimum). Other than these limits, the format of your written Application is up to you, but content must include:

- A. Name of Club
- B. Club member contact, including name, email, and phone number (cell preferred)
- C. Information on how the project meets BOTH criteria in Rule I
- D. (If available) key ideas depicted in your display that meets Rule II
