START	Does your club work with Interact, Rotaract, or Young Rotary?	YES, go to Track #2 NO Continue below
#1	Is contact with youth/at-risk populations Infrequent (1x occurrence and non-significant) or Incidental?	YES Go to Track #1 No Go to Track #2 Unsure See *Grey Area
#2	Is contact with youth/at-risk populations Frequently/Reoccurring or x1 Significant Occurrence or more.	YES, Go to Track #2 Unsure See *Grey Area

***Grey Area** Are you unsure of the definition of Track 1 or Track 2 or do you feel your club's sponsored events could meet the definition of a grey area? **Contact your District Youth and At-risk Protection Officer** or error on the side of caution and go directly to **Track #2**.

Track #1: Our club works with youth and At-risk Population Infrequent (a non-significant 1x occurrence)/incidental (does not establish a pattern) and with non-significant Contact. If yes, your club will need to:

- Review D5450 & RI Youth & At-risk Policy (Must Confirmed Attendance & Non-attendees must review.)
- Request and Complete D5450 Youth Awareness Tutorial/Quiz
- Rotarians and Non-Rotarians may complete a 5 minute Online D5450 Background Check (Cost under \$20)
- CLUB COMPLIANCE & ATTESTATION FILLED OUT ONLINE <https://rotary5450.org/sitepage/youth-at-risk-protection> by August 20th

We feel our club's program(s) fall into a grey area or we are unsure. **Support Required:** *Grey Area Programs will be determined by your District Youth and At-risk Protection Officer, or you may error on the side of caution and proceed to option 2 and complete the requirements.*

Track #2: Our Club works with Interact, Rotaract, or young Rotary OR Youth and At-risk Population or has Frequently/Reoccurring Contact (by Rotarians & Non-Rotarians Volunteers) Rotary Sponsored programs that are Significant, Often, Regular-Ongoing, Repeated Occurrence. This contact can be in a group or one-on-one setting and may be supervised or unsupervised Supervised Preferred Examples may be an on-going presentation to classroom or a group of Youth or a significant event with youth or at-risk populations. If YES, you shared that your Club works with Young Rotary, Interact or Rotaract: Clubs that work with Interact, Rotaract, or young Rotary and will need to:

- Review D5450 & RI Youth & At-risk Policy (Must Confirmed Attendance & Non-attendees must review.)
- Request and Complete D5450 Youth Awareness Tutorial/Quiz
- Rotarians and Non-Rotarians need to complete a 5 minute Online D5450 Background Check (Cost under \$20)
