WHEN: Late April/Early May - the duration of the trip will be approximately 12-14 days and will occur early May 2019 - most likely the first two weeks of May

OBJECTIVES of this year's District 7780 International Exchange trip to Romania:

- A portion of trip will be Rotarian home hosted
- Visit Caminul Felix a "family" style orphanage, where children live together with foster parents, with a working dairy farm, workshop, bakery, carpentry shop and crafts/sewing shop;
- Experience the micro-credit program that supports young entrepreneurs
- Learn and experience an ongoing program for children with Autism;
- Learn about a proposed project that would provide summer programs for children affected by the conflict in Ukraine.
- A final requirement of this trip will be for all the travelers to prepare and present the experience at various Rotary gatherings in District 7780 such as club/area meetings;

COST: A portion of the trip expenses will be covered by a District Foundation Grant but not all. The grant monies will go towards airfare, food, lodging, and in country transportation however all travelers will be responsible for a portion of their travel expenses yet to be confirmed but *could* be in the range of \$1000. In addition, each traveler will be expected to pay for passport, visa and any immunizations needed.
