### **FUNDRAISING**

#### Pints for Polio (Graphics, Collaborative, New people)

"Pints" at either a local brewery, restaurant, or ice cream shop

- One Pint at a Time Breweries, restaurants, or ice cream parlors agree to donate \$1 per pint sold.
- Parties with a Purpose! (For inspiration, google: Pints for Polio Rotary Club of Austin)
- Pub Crawl (For ideas, google: Pints for Polio Rotary Club of Greater Bend)

#### Restaurant Fundraiser (Graphics, Collaborative, New people)

One Bite at a Time - A restaurant fundraiser is a social event where a group eats at a restaurant on a particular day and the restaurant agrees to donate back a set percentage of sales to the PolioPlus fund.

#### Wine tasting at a club member's home or other venue (Graphics, Collaborative, New people)

Wine Tasting is an exceptionally popular social event.

Last year, RC Oxford Hills held a Toll Booth event and raised \$2,219.84 in just four hours!

#### Purple pinkie events (Graphics, Collaborative)

Do you have an Earlyact, Interact, or Rotaract Club? Ask them to hold a Purple Pinkie fundraiser

- Purple pinkie challenge Fundraising at local sporting events (RC of Wilmington/Interact and Manteno/Interact raising funds at the annual Wilmington-Manteno high school football game)
- Purple Pinky Day at the local Rotary Club members of Interact come to RC meeting and paint member's pinky for \$10+

### **RAISING AWARENESS**

Purple 4 Polio (Graphics, Collaborative, New people)

- Sell purple crocus bulbs at local Farmers Markets with the PolioPlus story
  - Plant bulbs in prominent locations in town in connection with city parks departments, nursing homes etc

#### Bridge the Gap to End Polio (Graphics, Collaborative, New people)

- Thousands of Rotarians put on red ponchos and march through the streets of their towns on World Polio Day. Locally, hundreds of Rotarians, family members, friends and community members have walked the Memorial Bridge connecting Portsmouth, NH and Kittery, ME to raise awareness and funds for Polio Plus.
