Includes the building & installation of a fresh produce storage & display unit, the maintenance of existing shelf units & initiating a program to replace aging freezer and refrigeration equipment. Plan includes a ten year replacement schedule.
Bridgton-Lake Region INTERNATIONAL Water & Sanitation	\$4,516.00	El Tesoro Del Saber School Water & Sanitation Project in Don Gregorio, Dominican Republic – to implement changes in elementary school to include bathroom facility upgrades, hygiene training and playground cleaning.
Brunswick Coastal INTERNATIONAL Basic Education & Literacy	\$3,711.00	Outfit Bweya Katwe Classroom Building (Uganda) – Outfit a school building recently constructed by partner Kajjansi Rotary Club with desks, chairs, blackboards, supplies. It also adds windows and doors to secure the building when not in use.
Damariscotta-Newcastle LOCAL Maternal & Child, Health, Education & Literacy	\$3,300.00	Helping End Food Insecurity in Lincoln County – countywide informational campaign to reinforce dissemination of available resources for those in need. Designing & printing posters. Supply scholarship funds for cooking classes, begin community garden initiatives for food insecure people, supplying volunteers to work in the classes, volunteers to purchase food and assemble in backpacks and volunteers to distribute posters.
Exeter INTERNATIONAL Water & Sanitation	\$4,882.52	Sowing & Watering the Seeds of Rotary in Cuba – 2 Viqua UVMAX D4-Plus System UV Water Purification Systems (including all parts required for installation)
Falmouth LOCAL Economic & Community Development	\$3,500.00	Culinary/Wellness Program for Growing Refugee Population in Local Community – Falmouth and Westbrook Rotary to provide qualified speakers on topic of wellness/nutrition & career opportunities. Year’s worth of nutritional foods to program. Benefits 500+ youth, 60-90 kids daily – at risk kids.
Kittery INTERNATIONAL Water, Sanitation & Hygiene	\$4,382.52	WASH in School (Guatemala) – Provides water filters and education on how to use them and maintain them to approximately 50 families who do not have access to potable water in their home. Children will learn basic hygiene habits (hand washing, tooth brushing)
Ogunquit INTERNATIONAL Economic & Community Development	\$3,500.00	Columbian School Feeding Project – provides up to date kitchen equipment and covered dining patios in rural villages of Columbia.

Portland LOCAL Economic & Community Development	\$2,250.00	Childhood Hunger in Portland, Maine. Project to increase registration in food insecurity programs at Portland public schools, increase participation & increase consumption.
Saco Bay LOCAL Economic & Community Development	\$3,000.00	Wheelchair Access Ramp at the Ballpark in Old Orchard Beach, ME. Partnering w/ Biddeford-Saco Rotary in building a 90 ft long ramp in order to provide access to those required the use of a wheelchair.
Yarmouth LOCAL Economic & Community Development	\$1,561.25	Benches for West Side Trail (WST) Fabricate and install 19 benches along the length of the West Side Trail, an 8 mile long trail. The benches to provide users with convenient resting spots along the trail.
