

Bethel



S. Portland-Cape Elizabeth

The Rotary Club of South Portland-Cape Elizabeth has donated \$60,000 to the Southern Maine Community College Foundation to fund annual scholarships for SMCC students.

The SPCE Rotary Club issued a check to the SMCC Foundation on July 29 to establish the South Portland-Cape Elizabeth Rotary Vocational Scholarship fund. The goal is to award at least two scholarships of \$1,500 per year.

For years, the Rotary Club has provided funding for scholarships for SMCC students, but wanted to formalize its relationship with the College by establishing an endowment that would fund scholarships in perpetuity.

It is my distinct privilege to present \$60,000 to SMCC from our charitable fund," said SPCE Rotary Club President Dr. David Bagdasarian. These scholarships will help students achieve their educational goals, enable the Rotary to support community college education, and enhance our longstanding relationship with SMCC."
