The Vocational Service Leadership Award recognizes Rotarians who have made a significant impact in advancing vocational service. District governors may nominate one candidate from their district each year.

## **Eligibility**

An individual may receive this award only once. Current, incoming, and past district governors, and current, incoming, and past RI directors are ineligible.
