District Grants



Districts choose which activities to fund through district grants so that they and their clubs can **address needs** in their communities and beyond.



Global Grants



Global grants fund **large-scale** international humanitarian projects, vocational training teams, and graduate-level scholarships that have **sustainable**, **measurable outcomes**.

Other Grant Types

Districts that are affected by events such as hurricanes, cyclones, earthquakes, and wildfires can apply for disaster response grants to support local recovery efforts.

Programs of scale grants fund locally led, evidencebased interventions that have **demonstrated their success**. The competitive program supports **longerterm** activities that align with one or more areas of focus and include strong elements of **monitoring**, **evaluation**, **and collaborative learning**.






Rotary Peace Centers

Polio Plus



The **PolioPlus Fund** is dedicated to the global eradication of polio. Donations to the PolioPlus Fund support vaccination efforts, supplies, and equipment for volunteers.



District 7780 members gave \$58,000 last year. Impact with the Gates Foundation Match was \$174,000 !

Our District members and clubs donated \$225,000 in 2017-2018. About half came back this year (\$113,000) divided equally between district grant and global grant funds.

This money is known as "District Designated Funds" or DDF.

Your donations in 2021-2022 will create the DDF for us in 2024-2025.






Rotary Direct
