Congratulations to District 7780 for the incredible support given to our Rotary Partner, ShelterBox. The District response to the disaster caused by Typhoon Haiyan, the largest and most devastating hurricane on record, has been tremendous. To date the District has provided over \$23,000, which will benefit up to 30 families, according to ShelterBox USA staff. A total of 1700 Boxes have been delivered and tents erected, and the total number of Boxes is expected to reach 7800 by the end of February, 2014.
