

Annual Review Outline
Vision to Plan Progress

Several Clubs in the District have decided to conduct an annual review of progress toward their 5-year vision. A review can be done during a Club Assembly or at a meeting of the Presidents Development Team. It should not take more than one hour. A typical agenda for such a review is:

1. Review status of Club Action Plan.
2. Review Statement of Purpose.
3. Review status of Presidents Development Team's efforts.
4. Review progress over past year in each category of the Wall Chart Summary. (This requires preparation.)
5. Determine what is working well and what needs improving.

The Club President and Club Vision Champion need to determine who is invited, and when / where such a review is held. They should consider inviting the Lead Facilitator and Assistant Governor.
