**To qualify for the 2010-2011 Governor's Citation**, each club must complete the activities below between July 1, 2010 and April 1, 2011 and submit to your Assistant Governor by April 2, 2011.

1. A club must have a speaker as a club program from at least six of the following District Committees in an effort to educate their members on Rotary and encourage participation in and promotion of the following activities:

- Membership
- Youth Services - Interact, RYLA, Youth Ex-change, Rotaract
- Vocational Service, especially in the area of Ethics
- Rotary Foundation
- Polio Plus
- Public Relations
- Community Service
- World Community Service - International
- Literacy
- Rotary International Fellowships/Action Groups

2. A club must take on a new service project or expand an existing one that meets the goals of the areas of focus and have sustainable impact in the communities where they will be implemented.

Areas of Focus:

- Peace and conflict prevention/resolution

- Disease prevention and treatment
- Water and sanitation
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- Maternal and child health
- Basic education and literacy
- Economic and community development

3. To support the \$200 Million Challenge to End Po-lio Now, a club must conduct a Fundraiser, alone or with another club or group, preferably involving the general public and submit the profits to the End Po-lio Now campaign. A club must also actively participate in Polio Awareness Week February 20-26, 2011 through Public Relations efforts via news-papers, radio, cable, television, etc. in promotion of Rotary's efforts to Eradicate Polio and in celebra-tion of Rotary International's birthday. Clubs are asked to contribute a minimum of \$2000 for the year towards the End Polio Now campaign.

4. A club must conduct a Club Vision Facilitation Program in an effort to gain membership retention and growth through the consensus, consistency and continuity created from a Visioning Session.

**To qualify for the Governor's Citation with High Distinction**  
a club must:

1. Complete the above criteria
2. Have minimum one new member net.
3. Reflect a 10% increase in the number of TRF Sus-taining members
4. Show a significant presence at the 2010 District Assembly, 2010-11 Membership and Public Rela-tions Seminar, 2010-11 Foundation Seminar and the 2011 District Conference.

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
