District Governor's Goals

The following goals were developed by DG Judy to support Rotarians in District 5020 in order that they may achieve their goals and further the ideals of Rotary.

Support & Strengthen Clubs

The District will:

- encourage clubs to interact and cooperate with one another in their pursuit of community and international service by creating a 'Service Treasure Chest' data bank on the District web site by July 1, 2012;
- provide quarterly training opportunities to assist Rotarians in their Rotary leadership development and succession planning;
- help celebrate the accomplishments of all clubs by encouraging the promotion of projects and fellowship activities on the District web site;
- promote sound financial stewardship by monitoring District expenditures and maintaining annual dues at the status quo; and
- celebrate the 2012-2013 Rotary year with a District Conference in Sidney, May 31, June 1 and 2nd, 2013.

Public Relations & Communication

The District will:

- incorporate the Governor's Newsletter into the District web site by July 1, 2012;
- distribute the Governor's monthly updates using social media and the District web site;
- promote monthly virtual meetings between Club and/or District leaders;
- encourage and support all clubs in the pursuit of PR grant applications; and
- encourage all clubs to promote their activities in local media.

Humanitarian Service:

The District will:

- continue to promote a minimum of 2 scholarship awards;
- continue to support and assist the Youth Exchange committee in providing a robust Youth Exchange program that adheres to RI and all applicable government regulations;
- promote and assist in the development of a defined Vocational Service program;
- support and assist clubs in their application for a minimum of 2 Vocational Training Team projects;
- continue to be a Peace Builder District by donating \$25,000 to the Rotary Peace Centres;
- support and assist in expanding New Generations to a minimum of 2 new Rotaract clubs and 2 new Interact clubs;
- encourage every club to initiate a Literacy project;
- encourage Rotarians to exceed their identified Foundation donations by 50%; and
- encourage clubs to reduce homelessness by making application to the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation using good stewardship and sound reporting processes.
