There are also presentations on Club constitutions, incorporation, membership development, risk management, privacy, insurance matters, meeting procedures, liaison with Probus South Pacific and how it may assist the club together with explaining the relationship between Rotary and Probus.

Attendees will find the day both rewarding and beneficial, particularly new office bearers. We need clubs willing to host these events; the club is responsible for selecting the venue, arranging the catering and collecting the registrations from attendees.

If any Clubs are interested, please contact me ASAP so we can select a convenient slot in the PSPL calendar. When things are in place, I urge Clubs to send at least one member of the Management Committee along – you won't be disappointed. Morning tea, a light lunch and afternoon tea are included in the registration, usually paid for by the attendee's Probus Club.
