

Don Bradman, one of Cootamundra's most famous son's, was born in Cootamundra in August 1908.With encouragement from the Australian Cricket Board, the Cootamundra Shire Council has established the *Captains' Walk*, the first stage of which was officially opened in August 1998. There are now 42 bronze sculptures of Australia's test captains in the park plus one of Unaarrimin, the leading Aboriginal player in the first Australian cricket team to tour England (1868). This amazing exhibit is really a <u>must see</u> while you are here on the Friendship Day. Quite apart from the Probus activities, like Forbes last year, Coota is a magnificent town with lots to do and see while you are visiting. And the two Cootamundra Probus Clubs are really firing and anxious for you to join with them on the Day.
