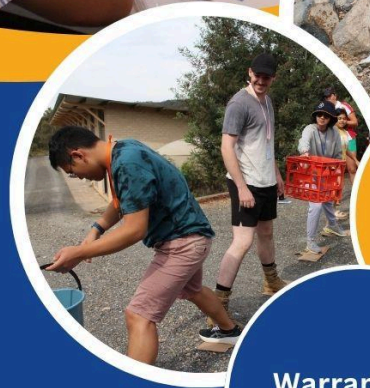


Rotary Youth Leadership Awards Rotary District 9705 Participant Information Pack 2025

Key Information

What is RYLA?

The Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) 7 day residential retreat is an opportunity for young people (aged 18-28) to develop the tools to become effective leaders in their communities. RYLA allows participants to build networks and develop their leadership skills to create the change they wish to see in the world.

What happens at RYLA?

RYLA offers a unique opportunity for participants to engage in diverse sessions, presented by experts and mentors, that develop the necessary skills in effective leaders. These sessions take multiple forms, including outdoor recreation, team coordination and planning tasks, as well as opportunities for personal reflection. The contents of these sessions are designed to challenge and develop leaders' skills in the following areas:

- Leadership Theory
- Ethics and Responsibility
- Conflict Resolution and Negotiation
- Facilitating Trust and Empowerment in Teams
- Organisation, Planning and Time Management
- Overcoming Adversity and Resilience

The program aims to help participants to:

- Build communication and problem-solving skills
- Discover strategies for becoming a dynamic leader
- Learn from community leaders, inspirational speakers and peer mentors
- Unlock their potential to turn motivation into action
- Have fun and form lasting friendships
- Further develop their own skills, talents and abilities, and
- Remember their responsibility to their communities and the world.

Who hosts RYLA?

RYLA is hosted by Rotary, a reputable non-profit organisation whose mission is to provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations and build goodwill and peace in the world. Rotary is a **non-religious, non-political** organisation and RYLA is operated by a volunteer Committee of members of Rotary and Rotaract Clubs in District 9705 and alumni of the program.

Who can apply?

Applications are open to young people aged between 18 and 28, who are located in the geographic region of Rotary District 9705.

Participants must be endorsed by a Rotary or Rotaract Club in District 9705, however they may be sponsored in whole or part by a Rotary or Rotaract Club, their employer, or choose to pay their own way. The total cost of the program for 2025 is \$1,700 (no GST applicable) per person, which covers participants from when they arrive at the venue to when they leave.

Frequently Asked Questions

What will RYLA do for your employees?

A challenging 7 day retreat, RYLA will offer your employees a unique networking opportunity to meet goal oriented and motivated individuals from different backgrounds and to access motivational speakers and experts in a variety of fields. The core curriculum utilises workshops and lectures that introduce the fundamentals of effective leadership. Your employees will have the opportunity to put their leadership skills into action in practical applications throughout the week.

Is the event accessible to people with a disability?

The RYLA Committee strives to make an inclusive and accessible event for all participants. Candidates should advise their requirements when applying so that the committee has an opportunity to review these and determine what actions can be taken to ensure the candidate will have an outstanding RYLA experience. The Committee will work closely with participants and the venue in the lead up to and during the event to ensure all requirements are met.

Considerations for Applicants

- Acceptance into RYLA is based on Endorsement by a local Rotary or Rotaract Club. Final decisions are at the discretion of individual Rotary or Rotaract Clubs and the District 9705 RYLA Committee.
- As Rotary and Rotaract Clubs and businesses invest significantly in sending applicants to RYLA, **it is extremely important that you are able to attend the retreat for the entire duration.** Participants are not permitted to leave the retreat location except in exceptional circumstances. Prior to submitting your application, please ensure you are able to take leave from work and schedule the time away.
- In completing the application form, you are consenting to the information on this form being collected for the purposes of organising the District 9705 Rotary Youth Leadership Award Retreat for January 2025. This information will be shared with parties that are responsible for the organisation of this event.
