District Grant 2113812 – Health: Covid 19

The Rotary Club of Mbuluzi Mbabane was granted R42 585 for Covid 19 health care PPE and related items to be administered by The Salvation Army. Our Rotarian, PAG Cynthia Dlamini, a nursing specialist, proposed the sewing of protective gowns for the front line health care workers at The Salvation Army clinics. These gowns are comfortable and washable and are therefore economical and environmentally friendly. The health workers responded with enthusiasm and different styles were chosen to suit circumstances. Cloth was purchased and a local women’s group sewed ninety gowns in a week. This provides three gowns for each health care employee. The gowns were embroidered with The Salvation Army logo and a number so that the gowns could be identified for each employee. The women’s group volunteered their own time to make masks from left over material from the gowns.
