



Mbabane Campus Rotaract Club worked in partnership with Mbabane-Mbuluzi Rotaract Club, Youth Discovery, Sigma on various projects, detailed information on the projects is herein stated below with each project are pictures to further show what the club did on the projects.

Mafutseni Project

On the 7th of November 2020, Mbabane Campus Rotaract Club in partnership with UNESWA Mbabane Campus department of community health nursing and Mbabane-Mbuluzi Rotaract Club visited a Dlamini family located in Mafutseni under the Manzini region. We were graced by the presence of a representative from the Deputy Prime Minister's office and the Swaziland Epilepsy Organisation.

The family consisted of 25 family members most of which were kids aged below the age 15, some adults which are unemployed and they all depended on Gogo Nkhosi who is also unemployed and not physically fit, she fed the family with the little she got from the elderly grant and she would borrow money to help feed her family.

We arrived at the homestead, and divided ourselves into groups since we had to complete different tasks to help the Dlamini family. We did the following activities;

- Some had to wash the clothes and blankets of the children and those of Gogo Nkhosi so to minimise their skin problem.
- Some helped with cleaning the houses where the family members slept and used on their daily bases and also cleaned the whole yard through collecting papers and sweeping the yard.
- Food parcels were donated to the family, which came from different donors.
- We started a garden for the family
- Provided moral support to Nakiwe who had been reported to be impregnated by her brother in law, since she was still at school, in form 1, a radio was donated so she could be able to catch up with the lessons being rendered on radio.
- Presented Skhanyiso, who was epileptic with epileptic drugs so to stabilise since he had run out of them.
- The family was given hand washing lessons so to keep their hands clean before handling food and after visiting the toilet.
- A meal was served after all activities were completed.

The elder, Gogo Nkhosi had a chance to say a few words, of which she expressed her gratitude towards our visit and that we did for her family.

On the 19th of December 2020, the club re-visited the Dlamini family at Mafutseni to have a christmas lunch with them, check on how they were doing and most importantly donate clothes to the family. We were welcomed with warm hands and thereafter got down to the business of the day, we had divided ourselves into groups, others kept the children entertained by playing games, sharing jokes and dancing with them, others attended to the cooking whilst others made sure that there was enough water in all water containers.

After all has been done with, we then all assembled and had lunch with the family, snacks were provided for the kids, then lastly the presentation of the clothes and stationery to the family. Each and every family member got a chance to be assisted by the club members in choosing clothes that would suit him or her properly.

Selulasandla Project

Mbabane Rotaract Club in partnership with Mbabane-Mbuluzi Rotaract Club had another project at Selulasandla Children's Village, Eveni in Mbabane on the 14th of November 2020, where we found children that lived there, although some were at school and the church elders who looked after the children.

We had prepared activities to be done on the day, so to help around.

- They had a garden but there were no vegetables planted, the clubs donated seedlings and helped in planting them.
- Food parcels were donated for the children
- We had a great time playing games with the children we found at the place
- A meal was served on the day

Speeches from the elders and a representative from the students, who expressed how grateful they were about our visit and that they were looking forward to our next visit.

Clothing Drive Project

In collaboration with YOUTH DISCOVERY and MBABANE-MBULUZI ROTARY CLUB, Mbabane Campus Rotaract club launched a clothing drive, which started on the 15th of November 2020 to the 9th of December 2020. This project was meant to get donations of clothes so that they can be further distributed to families identified by the club as to be in need of them.

Sitjeni Project

The Mbabane Campus Rotaract Club worked hand in hand with **Sigma** (global nursing excellence) in a project at Sitjeni community, where about 270 kids aged from 2 years old to about 20 years are given meals on a daily basis and are given basic life skills lessons. A donation of food parcels, toys, shoes and seedlings was made to the elders taking care of the children.

The children were served with a meal to enjoy and they also shared what they have been taught, as life skills lessons are offered to the kids by their care givers.
