

## Rotary District Grants (RID 6270) Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) 2026-27

What is the maximum size of a District Grant?

- \$3,000 is the maximum grant that can be awarded in 2026-27. It can be supplemented by the club with other funds if the total project cost is larger than \$3,000.

What are district grants used for?

- Humanitarian projects which improve health, support education, alleviate poverty or support the environment and support the mission of The Rotary Foundation.
- Projects that can be completed within the Rotary Year.
- Projects in which Rotarians are ACTIVELY involved – i.e. boots on the ground, hands-on activity.

What is the Mission of The Rotary Foundation?

- *“The Rotary Foundation helps Rotary members to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace by improving of health, providing quality education, improving the environment and alleviating poverty.”*

Who can apply for a District Grant?

- A District 6270 Rotary Club, Rotaract Club, or Satellite Club.

Is training required?

- At least 2 members of Clubs applying for 2026-27 District Grant **must** complete District Grant Education Seminar **before** application for a District Grant can begin.

When is education/training available for 2026-27 District Grants?

Where are applications made?

- Applications for 2026-27 District Grants must be submitted online in the ClubRunner Grant Module on Rotary District 6270 Website. This is discussed in District Grant Education Seminar.

When are Grant Applications due for 2026-27 District Grants?

- Applications are due June 1, 2026, for a Grant during the 2026-27 Rotary Year.

Can we use a district grant for an international project?

- YES - projects can be local or international if there is ACTIVE Rotarian/Rotaract involvement.

Can we give grant money to an organization to help with their expenses?

- NO - funds cannot be used for administrative expenses, salaries, operating costs of another organization.

We have a project underway now – can we receive district grant funding for that project?

- NO – projects that are underway or already completed, cannot be funded with district grants.

Is a Final Report required for a 2026-27 District Grant project?

- A Final Report on the project must be submitted by May 15, 2027. This is discussed in District Grant Education Seminar.
