

Looking for District 6270 Governor for 2021-2022

Our Rotary District is now seeking candidate proposals from Rotary Clubs for the position of District Governor in the 2021-2022 Rotary year.

Candidates are to be nominated by Rotary Clubs and have the support of their home Rotary Club.

Duties of the District Governor:

- The governor is the officer of RI in the district functioning under the general supervision of the RI Board. The governor leads and supports the clubs in the district by inspiring and motivating them and by ensuring continuity within the District. (from Rotary Manual of Procedure)
- Seeking candidates with strong leadership skills and decision making. During the years in office clubs will look to you for leadership, support and motivation as they carry out service projects and participate in Rotary programs.
- Strengthen clubs, organize new clubs, and grow membership. Encourage contributions and other support for The Rotary Foundation. Promote positive public image and serve as spokesperson for the district. Develop a safe environment for youth participants. Conduct a District Conference and other meetings. Supervise district nominations and elections. Prepare budget, provide annual report and help administer District Designated Funds. Complete online district qualification. Work with governor-elect and other district leaders (including create a district plan and appoint Assistant Governors and Committee Chairs).

Qualifications are:

- Be a District 6270 Rotarian in good standing.
- Rotarian maintaining full qualifications of membership

- Per RI Bylaws 16.070.3, a qualified Rotarian must have served a full term as club president, or as charter president from the date of charter to 30 June (six-month minimum), at the time of nomination.
- Nominees must have completed seven (7) years of Rotary Membership, by the time of taking office.

Nominees must complete a Governor-nominee Form. The form is found on District 6270 website, in 'site pages' listing.

Additionally:

- Candidates must participate in a committee interview process. Date and time will be scheduled and announced.
- Attendance is required at Zone Governor –Elect Training sessions (held in fall each year prior to taking office) and at International Assembly (held in January prior to the year taking office) immediately prior to taking office on July 1.
- Proposed candidates should discuss opportunities of this position with Past District Governors and those serving in the current DG leadership roles.
- Upon selection as District nominee, there are expectations of attendance at District meetings and Events.
