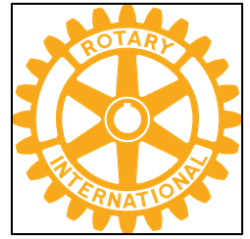

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT, BENEFITS, SUSTAINABILITY, OVERALL OUTCOME AND IMPACT. IN ADDITION, LIST YOUR NEEDS (materials, volunteers, funding assistance, etc.) :

The scope of the project was to distribute 250+ backpacks stuffed with age appropriate school materials to elementary school children enrolled in the MPS system. The congregation of the St. Mathew CME Church partnered with us in donating the use of their church, providing 10 volunteers, and donating 50 additional backpacks along with educational materials.

The prime benefit is to get the children off to a positive start for the 2016 school year. The children, their parents as well as their teachers all should benefit.

The overall outcome is that approximately 250 children received a backpack stuffed with items ranging from crayons to memory sticks based upon the age of the student. The impact is that 250 children will be better prepared for school than would be otherwise. The area of this project served is the poorest area in Milwaukee County. The hope is that these children will develop a love of learning which will give the educational opportunities to pull them out of poverty.

The needs for this project are listed below along with actual results:

- Volunteers (6 Rotarians, 10 members)
- Location (St. Matthew CME Church)
- Materials (backpacks, crayons, pencils, paper, spiral binders, folders, markers, memory sticks)
- Funding (\$2,500 district grant, \$750 materials provided by St. Mathew CME Church)
