National Domestic Violence Hotline: 800-799-7233 or 800-787-3224

*The National Network will automatically transfer you to the Rape Crisis Center nearest you, anywhere in the nation. It can be used as a last resort if people can not find a domestic violence shelter.

National Youth Crisis Hotline: 800-442-HOPE (4673)

Provides counseling and referrals to local drug treatment centers, shelters, and counseling services. Responds to youth dealing with pregnancy, molestation, suicide, and child abuse. Operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
