

Links to Rotary Background Checks for District 6270 Volunteers

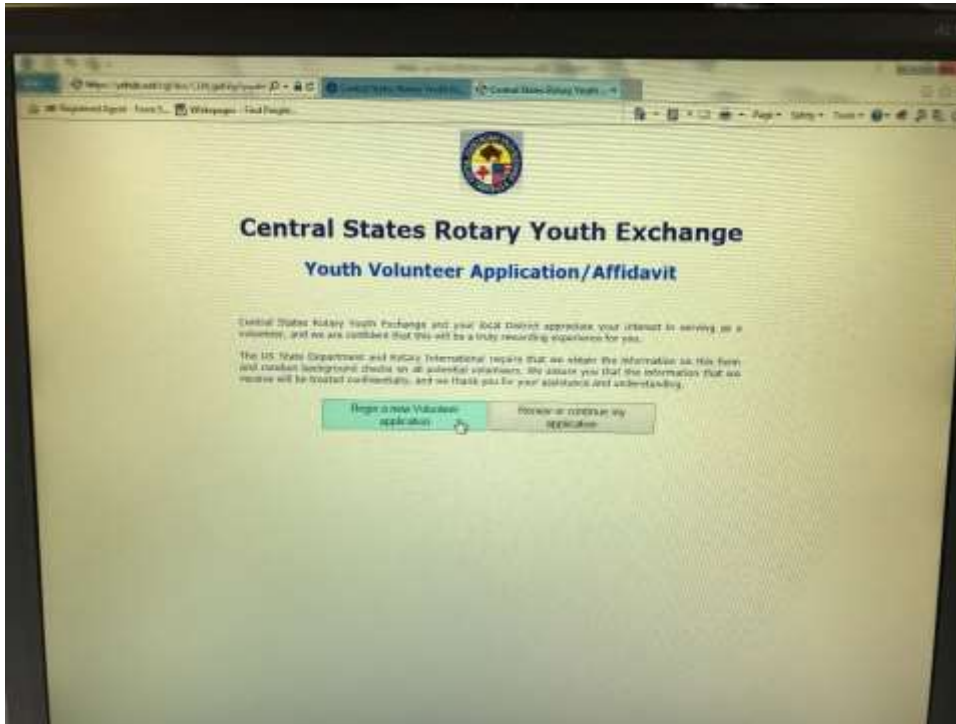
My name is John Scherer from the Delavan-Darien Rotary Club. I'm the Youth Protection Officer for District 6270. This letter explains the procedure for Rotary Volunteers to obtain a Rotary Background Check. Our Background Check Supplier, InCheck, Inc. provides the checks. They cost \$8.75 each. Some Rotarian's costs will be higher if they have had more than one last name. Each club will be billed for the background checks. All the work done to secure a background check (which is due once per year) is done online in a secure manner. There are no paper records kept anymore, except the one page Club Compliance Form.

If you're a Rotarian or Rotarian Family Member volunteering with Rotary Youth Exchange or other youth activity, you must obtain a background check once per year. To begin the process of securing a background check, start by clicking on this link: <http://www.csrye.org>

Go to that website and then, as the picture shows, go to "Forms" and slide down to "Volunteer Application"



Then click on “Begin a new Volunteer application”



Reminders:

- Rotary International strives to create and maintain a safe environment for all youth who participate in Rotary activities. To the best of their ability, Rotarians, Rotarians’ spouses and partners, and other volunteers must safeguard the children and young people they come into contact with and protect them from physical, sexual, and emotional abuse.
 - VOLUNTEER — Any adult involved with Rotary youth activities who interacts directly with youth, whether supervised or unsupervised. Youth programs include Youth Exchange, EarlyAct, Interact, mentoring programs, etc. For Youth Exchange, volunteers include, among others, club and district Youth Exchange officers and committee members; Rotarian counselors; Rotarians and non-Rotarians and their spouses and partners who work with students during activities or outings or who transport students to events; and host parents and other adult residents of the host home, including host siblings and other family members.
 - Background checks play a critical part in any youth protection policy because they deter potential offenders and detect known offenders. All adults (Rotarians and Non-Rotarians) that have direct, unsupervised contact with Rotary program participants in D6270 must have a criminal background check completed.
