

PROCEDURE FOR YOUTH POTECTION TRAINING

The abuse and harassment prevention training that we have done will now be done on line. This training is required every three years. At least one member of each club should have this training. This training is required for all clubs involved in activities that include youth, such as Interact, Rotaract, and many other youth activities, including young adults. If your club is participating in the youth exchange program then the student's counselor and the youth exchange officer must take this training.

Members must be registered in the system in order to take the training. It takes about 30-45 minutes to complete. To register you need to provide a volunteer affidavit for each person to be registered. Forward all to PDG Bob Hosch . There is no fee for this.

In addition the youth exchange officer must be certified by the U S Department of State prior to beginning the placement of any student. This must be done each year. For those involved in youth exchange should contact:

How does your club comply?

1-each member to be trained needs to complete a volunteer affidavit, if they have not done one in the past 3 years. There is no fee for this.

2-complete the abuse and harassment prevention training see above.

3-Have a criminal background report done, this is valid for one year, fee required. Fee is \$10.00 per report until 1/4/16 and \$12.95 thereafter.

Your club will be billed for the reports ordered.
