Hurricane Harvey Response

A message to Rotarians in District 6270

As you know many of the cites along the Gulf Coast of the United States, especially in Texas and Louisiana have been devastated by floods resulting from Hurricane Harvey. Immediate response is underway with numerous parties involved – individuals, churches, non-profit organizations, Coast Guard, National Guard, government at all levels and other groups.

Cities such as Rockport, Texas have been destroyed. The Houston area (population of over 6.5 million) has had massive evacuation. Some have been trapped inside their homes. In some areas, entire neighborhoods have been submerged.

People are faced with recovery. Many people have lost everything – shelter, clothing, food, even transportation. Many organizations are mobilizing to assist. Many Rotary districts, especially those in Texas, Louisiana, and Florida are working together and with other partners to help wherever needed. Districts 5810 and 6960 have partnered with Meals of Hope to help deliver 200,000 meals on Labor Day weekend. ShelterBox has been activated. Red Cross is responding. Recovery will be an ongoing effort for years.
