PLANNED ACTIVITIES

Breast cancer is one of the most important problem that threaten women's health; it affects the patient and her realtives physically, socially and emotionally. There is an increased risk of breast cancer in 1 of every 8 women. After cardiovascular diseases, cancer is second cause of death among women in Turkey . As in the world; the most common cancer type among women is breast cancer with 40% in Turkey. Our objective is to supply Adana Provincial Directorate of Public Health with 15 Breast Cancer Training Models. These models will be sent to the Public Health Centers in the districts of Adana and training programs for womens will be held by expertised doctors. The awareness against breast cancer will be increased and this will help them to detect their illness in early stages with the help of the Breast Cancer Training Models. There is only 1 Breast Cancer Training Model in Public Health Directorate and it is not enough for Adana.

Who will benefit from this global grant? Provide the estimated number of direct beneficiaries.

The beneficiaries are women over the age of 40 since %83 of the cases had seen after the age of 40 in Turkey. Our goal is to reach 10000 women each year in different districts of Adana.

SUSTAINABILITY

What community needs will your project address and how were these needs identified? Provide any relevant data or survey results

Distribution of breast cancer cases varies among different regions of Turkey due to geographic, economic, social, and cultural factors. Due to the higher educational rates and increased awareness of this illness; breast cancer is detected earlier in the western regions of Turkey. In eastern regions, breast cancer is mainly detected at the last stages of illness and mortality rates are higher than western regions. According to the Medical School of Istanbul University, 80% of the cases are early detected in western regions whereas 50% of the cases are early detected in eastern regions. And the survival rate is 85% in western regions and 50% in eastern regions. Therefore, early detection of breast cancer is very important and it can save more lives.

The location which this project will be held is Adana and it is the 5th biggest city in Turkey with its population of 2,125,981 (2011). According to Turkey Statistical Agency (TUIK) 50% of city population are women. Due to its high social, economic and transportational advantages Adana is a city which gets too many immigrants from eastern regions of Turkey. Therefore, educating and increasing the awareness of women in this region is very important to increase the rate of early detection of breast cancer. Currently, there is only 1 Breast Cancer Training model in Adana and The Provincial Directorate of Public Health is organizing education programs to women in some Public Health Centers. But it is not enough for a city of population over 2,000,000. Our Project will address 10,000 women each year, over the age of 40, in all districts of Adana and their awareness will be increased in order to detect breast cancer in its earliest stages.

Detail how your project will address these community needs.

15 Breast Cancer Training Models will be supplied to Adana Provincial Directorate of Public Health. The Directorate will organize training and education programs for women by expertised doctors. These programs will be held regularly in every district of Adana, mainly rural areas which has low-income and has lower level of awareness about breast cancer. The awareness to illness will be increased by these programs and this will lead an increase in early detection of breast cancer in Adana. Thus will increase the chance of living.

How were members of the local community involved in planning the project? Does your project align with any current or ongoing local initiatives?

Director of Public Health is involved in planning the Project. Director told that there is only 1 Breast Cancer Training Model in our city but noted that it is not enough to reach enough women. Adana is the 5th biggest city in Turkey with its population of 2,125,981 (2011). Adana city center which is populated around 1,600,000 consists of 5 districts named Seyhan, Çukurova, Yüreğir, Sarıçam and Karaisalı; but the whole city consists of 15 districts. Currently, there are some training programs for women held by that model but it is only held in city center. City center has the highest educational and awareness level. Therefore, more Breast Cancer Training Models will be very useful to organize training programs in the other districts of Adana which has lower level of awareness.

There will be training programs held by using the Breast Cancer Training Models. The training programs will be organized regularly by Adana Provincial Directorate of Public Health. The Directorate will inform Adana Rotary Club for each program.

How will you meet these goals?

We will donate Adana Provincial Directorate of Public Health with 15 Breast Cancer Training Models. They have only 1 model for so long time. Thus, they will make much more educational training programs for women in every district of Adana and they will reach much more women earlier.
