Dear Club President:

IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR AGAIN!!

The 2024 RYLA Leadership Conference will be held as usual over the Martin Luther King holiday weekend (Friday, January 12- Monday Noon, January 15, 2024) at the John Newcombe Tennis Ranch in New Braunfels, Texas and I can't tell you how excited we are about the 2024 RYLA event! As always, we are bringing back approximately 26-29 outstanding juniors from 2023 as Team Leaders and they have already met and begun planning the 2024 leadership event so we are looking forward to their new, innovative ideas and I can promise your students a tremendous and memorable leadership experience. For those clubs and Presidents just getting involved, RYLA is District 5840's way of recognizing our outstanding youth. More than 160 junior class students will attend the weekend and be led by the 28+ selected peer leaders (TLs) who actually plan and execute the program. There are always at least three major, hands-on leadership workshops and this year, there will be some new programs and surprises that I know the students will enjoy and get a lot out of. As always, there will be plenty of food, snacks, entertainment and just plain fun over the weekend.

The RYLA concept is quite simple but very effective. Guest speakers conduct "Hands On" and interactive sessions on leadership, trust, cooperation, communication, teamwork and other meaningful and topical subjects. After each presentation the students meet in small groups to discuss the topics and their views and share with the others in their group and the students have some pretty lively debates and discussions. The response is GREAT... the students find it informative and enjoyable and Rotary is the forum to get our message out about leadership and service.

Hopefully, this brief description will suffice to get your candidates as excited to come as we are to offer the program.

At this point, I hope you will move swiftly toward selecting at least two (more if you want) outstanding JUNIOR (only) students from the high schools in your club area (preferably one boy and one girl).

Like previous years, the workshop is being held over the Martin Luther King holiday, and will be over three nights (Fri. evening through Mon noon). Additional details of arrival time, map etc. will be forwarded at a later date.

This is what we need for you to do:

1. **DON'T SIT ON THIS LETTER.....ACT ON IT YOURSELF OR IMMEDIATELY TURN IT OVER TO YOUR YOUTH CHAIRMAN OR BETTER STILL APPOINT A RYLA CHAIRMANFOLLOW UP ON EVERY STEP. PLEASE! PLEASE! PLEASE!**
2. Select the students - How? Ask your high school counselor or administrator to recommend two (2) or more, outstanding students from the junior class. Be sure and tell them that they may use this program as that little extra boost or push for that potential outstanding young leader who doesn't always get the recognition. Rotary foreign exchange students are always welcome should you choose to send them, in fact we encourage it and they become an integral part of the RYLA experience.
3. Be sure your counselor and students know that the conference is over three (3) nights and once registered they will have to remain for the duration. No student will be permitted to arrive after the announced registration time nor will they be permitted to leave early..... please no exceptions. If selected students have basketball, SAT etc. please select other participants. Rest assured, as always, the students are totally cared for and under the constant supervision of adult chaperones and peer Team Leaders. , day and night.

ROTARY YOUTH LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE 2024

Dear RYLA Nominee.....CONGRATULATIONS on being chosen by your school and the Rotary Clubs of District 5840 to participate in the 2024 Rotary Youth Leadership Assembly (RYLA). This is truly a unique and exciting conference/workshop and we hope that you will realize and appreciate the honor in having been selected to attend. Below are the Who, What, Where, etc. for this fantastic weekend.

WHAT IS RYLA ?

RYLA stands for the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards and the purpose is to give you (and 160+ other students from around Texas) an opportunity to learn and to exchange ideas on leadership techniques and topical issues with outstanding community and student leaders. The entire weekend is an interactive weekend with every session building on the previous one. After a presentation by one of our powerful facilitators, student Team Leaders (TL's) will moderate small group dialogues and I know that you will find these discussions interesting, thought provoking, entertaining and exciting. One session that I know that you will enjoy and learn from, is an entire workshop, with hands on participation, on effective leadership in high school. This workshop is conducted by one of San Antonio's most enthusiastic and outstanding past educators and speakers and we are confident you will come away with some new ideas and insight into being a more dynamic and effective leader both in and out of your school. I know you will enjoy the other hands on and interactive workshops on the program as well as a challenging low ropes course. Don't worry...there is plenty of game and fun time over the weekend.

WHEN ?

RYLA takes place over the Martin Luther King holiday weekend.....January 12-15, 2024 and **you should plan to arrive at the John Newcombe Tennis Ranch Lodge (directions attached) between 6:00 and 7:00 PM on Friday night, January 12** and don't worry about eating before hand, a dinner buffet (including vegetarian dishes) along with dips and fruit will be set up during registration.

We understand that many of you are very involved in other activities (basketball, soccer, SAT etc.) or may have schedule conflicts however, once you agree to attend and arrive at Newk's, you will not be permitted to leave until the conference is over (**ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS** except for illness). As you can see, the conference is over four days due to the Martin Luther King school holiday (for most districts), so please take note and make your plans accordingly. Additionally, because of the camp setting, no one will be permitted late registration. If you must decline tell your school counselor or Rotary Club so that substitutions can be made or call me and I'll take care of it.

WHERE ?

RYLA takes place at the **JOHN NEWCOMBE TENNIS RANCH, in New Braunfels**. The entrance to the Ranch is on **Highway 46 at Mission Valley Rd..** Look for the big lighted ARROW Sign at night and the big water tower that says "Newk's Resort" (a little hard to see in the dark but...when you see the large lighted entrance to T Bar M Tennis Facility.....NEWKS is the next road on the left if you are coming from the east on HWY 46 or on the Right if you are coming from US281 or Hwy 46 West and follow the RYLA direction signs to the **Main Lodge** and RYLA Team Leaders will be available to help you find your cabin and help with your luggage. If you are driving your own car, you will be shown where to park and you will not be permitted to drive until you leave at the end of the weekend. The conference will conclude at 12:00 Noon on Monday 15th (parents, no earlier..please) on Monday, January 15th Parents or other drivers, you will pick your student(s) up at the same location where you drop them off. Emergency (only) phone numbers follow should it be necessary to get a message to your student: **Newk's - (830) 625-9105** or **Ron Greenberg - (210) 410-2761** (24 hour mobile). The entire weekend is totally chaperoned, night and day, by a number of Rotarians and other adult leaders as well as the John Newcombe Staff (Mom and Dad take note).

WHAT TO BRING

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ AND TAKE NOTE - You will be in a camp setting in bunk bed style cabins (comfortable-not rustic). Newk's has the beds and linens however, **YOU are responsible for your own pillows and sleeping bags if you prefer, towels, soap etc..** Dress throughout the entire weekend is casual and comfortable (jeans to dressy). REMEMBER the weather can change at any time **SO BRING A COAT, SWEATER, RAINCOAT ETC.** Many of the conference activities are scheduled outdoors (ropes course, games, etc.) so **bring sneakers (maybe even an extra pair), warmups and/or "climbing clothes" (those that can get dirty etc.).** Be sure to bring your alarm clock (Mom or Dad won't be there to gently shake you awake). NOTE: Although the dorms and cabins are locked during the day, there are in excess of 200 students attending so you might want to leave your more expensive items of electronics/jewelry et at home. We have not had problems in the past but better safe than sorry plus the fact that you will be busy having fun throughout the weekend.

OTHER STUFF

There will be an informal get aquatinted party on Friday evening after registration, a games/social event on Saturday night (the RYLA Olympics) and we have other entertainment planned throughout the weekend

Our schedule is extremely busy, however, throughout the conference you will have periods of free time to just relax and get to know the other students and enjoy the facility.

Non-denominational religious services (optional) and Catholic Mass will be held Sunday morning at Newk's.

UP FRONT RULES (other rules will be given to you later)

This entire conference and weekend **IS** a **smoke free weekend**. Tobacco products of any kind (cigarettes, vaping, Scoal etc.) are prohibited (TL's rules) so please take note.

If you come with an open mind and are prepared to fully participate (the willingness to “step out of your comfort zone”), we guarantee that you are going to have an absolutely amazing, tremendous, worthwhile and fun weekend and we really are excited about having you!!!

Direction to the John Newcombe Tennis Ranch

From Austin/Dallas

Hwy 35 south to New Braunfels (approximately 45 miles south of Austin)

Exit # 189 (Seguin/New Braunfels)

Turn right at stop light-you will then be going west on loop 337

Go 5 miles on loop 337 until you come to the Hwy 46 exit – take that exit and turn left at stop light

Go about 3 miles on Hwy 46 and you will see a big Lighted direction ARROW and the Newk's water tower on your left that says, "Newk's Resort" Turn left at the arrow on to (Mission Valley Road and go about ¼ mile The main entrance will be on your left. The Main Lodge is by the parking lot

From Houston

Hwy 10 west to Seguin

Take the New Braunfels exit and go west on Hwy 46. Stay on it about 15 miles to New Braunfels

When you go under Hwy 35 in New Braunfels, Hwy 46 turns into loop 337 (McDonald's on the right)

Go 5 miles on loop 337 until you come to the Hwy 46 exit – take that exit and turn right at stop light

Go about 3 miles on Hwy 46 and you will see a Large Lighted ARROW pointing the way and a big water tower on your left that says, "Newks Resort"

Turn left at the ARROW on to Mission Valley Road) and go about ¼ mile

The main entrance will be on your left. The Main Lodge is by the parking lot

From San Antonio

Hwy 35 North to New Braunfels

Take the Rueckle Road Exit #184-turn left at the stop sign and pass over Hwy 35

You will be on loop 337, Go 5 miles on loop 337 until you come to the Hwy 46 exit – take that exit and turn left at stop light

Go about 3 miles on Hwy 46 and you will see the **large Lighted Entry** to the T Bar M Newk's is the next road on your left (Mission Valley) you will see the big Lighted directional ARROW on your left .

Turn left at the Lighted Arrow (Mission Valley Road) and go about ¼ mile

The main entrance will be on your left. The Main Lodge is by the parking lot

From Boerne/ West Texas

Hwy 10 East to Hwy 46 Exit

Go east on Hwy 46 towards New Braunfels

We are 15 Miles east of Hwy 281

You will see a Large lighted directional ARROW. turn right on to Mission Valley Road and go about ¼ mile The main entrance will be on your left. The Main Lodge is by the parking lot

(if you miss your turn from Hwy 46 and see the **Large Lighted Entry** to the **T BAR M** you have gone too far ...so.....turn back and go back to Mission Valley Road (you'll see the highway marker telling you to turn left.
