PETS Makeup policy

The Rotary International Manual of Procedures lists qualifications for each office within the District or Club and with specific reference to Club Presidents- Elect:

"The President- Elect shall attend the District President- Elect Training Seminar and the District Training Assembly unless excused by the District Governor-Elect. If so excused, the President-Elect shall send a designated club representative who shall report back to the President- Elect. If the President-Elect also does not attend the District Training assembly and has not been excused by the District Governor-Elect or if excused, does not send a designated representative to such meetings, the President-Elect shall not be able to serve as club president until a successor who has attended the President-Elect Training Seminar and the District Training Assembly or has had training deemed sufficient by the District Governor has been duly elected."

Non-attendance at PETS by the President elect has serious implications for Rotary clubs.

District 5960 is a member of the North Central PETS (a member of the Multi-District PETS Alliance). NCPETS is conducted each year in March. A fee is charged for all registrants to cover costs of materials and meeting expenses including meals..

To assist in complying with Rotary International requirements for Presidents-Elect to attend a PETS training, the District 5960 District Governor- Elect will conduct a PETS make up session. The session will cover material the President- Elect needs to assume office of President. A fee will be charged for the makeup session. The makeup session will not include material from general plenary sessions nor will attendees have the same opportunity for wider networking with their class colleagues.

PETS make up fees are collected and retained by District 5960 (not NCPETS) to cover the cost of the session.
