The Food Bank of the Rio Grande Valley is currently coordinating with H-E-B Stores (Valleywide), local charities, state/county emergency management officials, Bert Ogden, CBS4 and iHeart Radio in response to the current flooding event impacting communities in Hidalgo, Cameron and Willacy counties.

The Food Bank RGV has already directly given food and water relief to nearly 4,000 residents and has distributed a total of 70,000 pounds of food and water.
