TRAINING OBJECTIVES:

Understand The Rotary Foundation Grants Funding Model and how to successfully manage a Rotary Foundation Global and/or District grants and

1. Learn the benefits and use of District Designated Funds (DDF) to support your club's Global and District grant projects
2. Complete the Required Grants Training for Your Club Certification and Club Memo of Understanding as required by The Rotary Foundation and District 5930. Each club must have a minimum of **two certified trained** club members each Rotary year. Even if you were certified for last year's grants, you must attend this year to submit a grant in 2015-2016.
3. Become familiar with the Grant(s) Application and Online Submission Processes
4. Prepare your club to implement the club memorandum of understanding
5. Learn about The Rotary Foundation's stewardship expectations
6. Qualified Rotary clubs will be eligible to receive Rotary Foundation grant funding in 2015-2016
