The Laredo Gateway Rotary Club, in conjunction with County Commissioner Rosaura Tijerina and the Webb County Community Center at Larga Vista in Precinct No. 2, will provide 3 folding tables and 40 folding chairs, all with Laredo Gateway Rotary logos, to the Larga Vista Kids Café and Library, a center that provides underprivileged children with meals, study materials, and computers. Laredo Gateway Rotary will also post a large banner with its own logo, this year's "Be a Gift to the World" theme and District 5930, on the banner. Gateway Rotary will present the tables and chairs at a Rotary Day, which will be a service project to read with, tutor, and mentor the students of Larga Vista. Gateway Rotary will also work to schedule these service projects at least once a semester.

The Larga Vista Webb County Community Center serves an low-income area of Laredo, Texas, with children that sometimes do not receive any meals but the ones served at the Center. The Community Center is in need of additional tables and chairs to serve the ever-increasing number of underprivileged children in the area. The intended beneficiaries are the underprivileged children and non-english speaking adults of the Larga Vista area.

The Kids Café serves 1,487 meals per month and the Library serves 656 children per month. The Library includes reference books, fiction books, computer work stations, and TVs where the children can do homework and spend time after school. Additionally, the Community Center has teamed up with Laredo Community College to offer ESL and GED classes to adults.

The Laredo Gateway Rotary Board approved a request from the Webb County Community Center at Larga Vista to provide support for the Kids Café and Library programs. The Larga Vista Community Center is a place where families in underprivileged areas can go for assistance in many different areas, including utilities such as light, water, and gas, hot meals Monday through Friday, medical assistance, and food bags for qualifying residents. Laredo Gateway Rotary helps support the community center in its basic educational efforts.

The Larga Vista Webb County Community Center serves an low-income area of Laredo, Texas, with children that sometimes do not receive any meals but the ones served at the Center. The Community Center is in need of additional tables and chairs to serve the ever-increasing number of underprivileged children in the area. The intended beneficiaries are the underprivileged children and non-english speaking adults of the Larga Vista area.

The Kids Café serves 1,487 meals per month and the Library serves 656 children per month. The Library includes reference books, fiction books, computer work stations, and TVs where the children can do homework and spend time after school. Gateway Rotary will present the tables and chairs at a Rotary Day, which will be a service project to read with, tutor, and mentor the students of Larga Vista. Sponsoring club members, through the service committee, will work to purchase the tables and chairs, and will work to place the Laredo Gateway Rotary logo on the donated tables and chairs. Laredo Gateway Rotary will also post a large banner with its own logo, this year's "Be a Gift to the World" theme and District 5930, on the banner.

Gateway Rotary will present the tables and chairs at a Rotary Day, which will be a service project to read, tutor, and mentor the students of Larga Vista. Gateway Rotary will also work to schedule these service projects at least once a semester. Club members will present the tables and chairs, and spend a morning or afternoon - depending on the community center schedule - reading, tutoring, and mentoring the children who utilize the Library and Kids' Café.

The implementation project date will depend upon receipt of the District Grant funds, and can be scheduled before the end of 2015. A service project will be scheduled as a spring back to school event in January 2016, so that members can read with, tutor, and mentor the children of the Larga Vista area.
