Camper Orientation Meeting – May through June

To confirm the attendance of the campers selected for your club's RYLA program, we strongly advise organizing an orientation meeting for the entire group of campers. If needed, individual meetings can be arranged to ensure their availability for the camp. The event that they cannot attend, alternative candidates may be considered, or the scholarship funds can be reallocated to support other campers in the district.

At the orientation meeting (usually 2-6 weeks before RYLA), you should plan to provide the following:

1. List of items to bring to the camp:

2. Transportation information:

*Please note, two adults are required in the transportation of campers. If only one adult is available, Rotary District 5520 requires a background check.
