To qualify for the Rotary Service Award complete three required and any two elective acts of service during the 2017-2018 Rotary year. All activities are self-reported, and recognition will be offered following submission. All applications received by April 1, 2018 will be eligible for recognition at the District Conference April 26-29, 2018.
