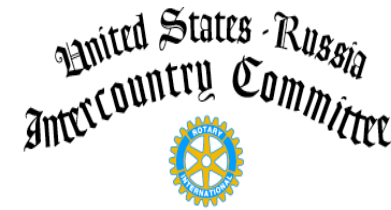


Home hosting before and after the conference will be available to our visiting Russian Rotarians.
