Rotary has been working to eradicate polio for more than 35 years. Our goal of ridding the world of this disease is closer than ever. As a founding partner of the **Global Polio Eradication Initiative**, we've reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent since our first project to vaccinate children in the Philippines in 1979. Today, polio remains endemic only in Afghanistan and Pakistan, with seven cases reported this year. It is crucial to continue working to keep other countries polio-free. If all eradication efforts stopped today, within 10 years, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year.

As we begin the last quarter of this Rotary year, let's push to end Polio. Rotary International has asked each Rotary club to donate \$1500 or more to www.EndPolio.org. We thank those of you who have contributed this year and ask others to consider a donation. All gifts continue to be matched 2:1 by The Gates Foundation.

THE ROTARY ENDOWMENT

\$2.025 Billion in year 2025, Rotary is on the cusp of reaching this lofty goal

Establishing Rotary's Endowment has become a major contribution to building the future of Rotary's world impact. Not only is the Endowment helping to assure our impact for years to come, but the existence of the Endowment also helps demonstrate to Rotary's partners that its programs are sustainable and can be relied upon far into the future.

Contributions to the Endowment are increasingly encouraged because as Rotary continues to build endowed capacity, all of Rotary's impact is enhanced.

The Trustees of The Rotary Foundation are responsible for setting the investment policy, including the investment objectives and asset allocation strategy.

Contributions to the Endowment are invested to provide a long-term and sustainable source of funding. The Foundation Trustees determine what percentage of the earnings will be used to support programs each year. These earnings fund important activities today and provide stability for the future. The Endowment also protects against inflation and severe market fluctuations.

Donors can specify the use of their contributions among the same Rotary funds that they support annually, including:

- SHARE — provides District Designated Funds for district and global grants, and World Fund
- World Fund — provides the matching funds for global grants and unrestricted support
- Global grants — provides a periodic global grant for your district

Through these and other fund designations, many districts are carrying out work today that donors funded decades ago by giving to the Endowment.

The two main ways in which people can support the Endowment are through outright gifts and with commitments to give later, known as bequests.


Outright gifts involve an immediate transfer of cash or publicly traded securities of any amount. Donors can also propose other types of gifts that comply with The Rotary Foundation’s Gift Acceptance Policy. An outright gift of any amount helps build the fund and can have a lasting impact on a district’s ability to plan future service activities. Outright gifts also give donors a glimpse of their legacy and allow Rotary to recognize that generosity with them, their family, and their friends.

Commitments for later gifts, or bequests, usually involve specifying a donation in a will, estate plan, or similar document. Donors who make bequests often receive satisfaction from knowing that their charitable goals will be fulfilled with assets they no longer need.
